We have had a fantastic week of learning at Red House and students have made great progress.


In English all year groups are working on Shakespeare, year 9 and 10 are studying Romeo and Juliet as part of their GCSE text for English literature. Year 11 have been focusing on GCSE language paper 1 in preparation for their upcoming mock exam on Tuesday.

In Science Year 9 have been exploring Biomimicry as an introduction to GCSE. So far this has included exploring glider design and its effects on speed, how engineers can use termite mounds to help them design buildings with temperature control and how we might be able to utilize bioluminescence and how spiny head worms have helped us to improve skin grafts.
